for 29-Hour Home Rebuild**

Keansburg, NJ – October 30, 2014 – Officials in Keansburg, New Jersey held a media conference on October 28 to launch a 29-hour home rebuild in Keansburg to commemorate the second anniversary Superstorm Sandy and to raise awareness of the patience, strength and resiliency of the families that are still facing challenges.

Through an ongoing partnership between St. Bernard Project (SBP) and Farmers Insurance, volunteers will work 29 straight hours – from Tuesday October 28 to Wednesday, October 29 – to help rebuild the damaged home of Hilton Dantas, a Keansburg resident.
