Borough of Keansburg, NJ Celebrates the Progress of new Caruso Elementary School’s Construction with a “Beam Signing” Ceremony

Keansburg, NJ – April 24, 2015 – On April 22, Keansburg School District officials, New Jersey Schools Development Authority (SDA) CEO Charles McKenna, local officials and Keansburg students joined together at the construction site for the new Joseph C. Caruso Elementary School for a “beam signing” ceremony to celebrate its progress.

Those in attendance were able to forever leave their mark by signing a steel beam, which will later be a permanent part of the new school.

The new Joseph C. Caruso Elementary School will be the first new school in Keansburg built by the SDA at the site of the former 58,000-square-foot school. The new school is designed to educate approximately 750 students in kindergarten through fourth grades. The 122,000-square-foot school will include 28 general use classrooms, eight kindergarten classrooms, self-contained special education classrooms, a media center, a gymnasium and a cafeteria.
