

Voluntary Flood Mitigation and Elevation Assistance

Are you Eligible for Flood Elevation Assistance?

You may be eligible for elevation assistance through a new Federal Emergency Management Agency grant for flood mitigation assistance if you meet any of the following criteria:

- Your municipality is actively participating in the National Flood Insurance Program, and has not withdrawn, is on probation, or suspended.
- Your home has a history of Repetitive Loss (RL), Severe Repetitive Loss (SRL) or was deemed “substantially damaged” after a major disaster declaration and has yet to be elevated.
- Buildings identified must have been in an NFIP policy (including Group Flood Insurance Policy) and must be maintained through the life of the building, regardless of the flood zone.

The Borough is actively working toward acquiring elevation assistance for your private residence through this Individual Flood Mitigation Assistance Swift Current Initiative funded by the Bipartisan Infrastructure Law.

Keansburg maintains a list of potentially eligible structures and will send out a mail notice of this announcement to all on the list. If you are unsure of your status, please contact the Keansburg Assistant Zoning Officer at 732-787-0215 ext.220 to discuss. Leave your full name, contact number, and full address of the property in all email correspondence and voicemails.
